The minimum eligibility criteria for selection of the entity will be as follows:

After successful completion of first phase, AYCL will implement it in the remaining garden in phased manner. It is planned to complete the project within a years' time.

PENALTY /LIQUIDATED DAMAGES CLAUSE:

If the supply & installation is delayed beyond the date of scheduled date of execution in the order, penalty will be levied @ 1/2% per week subject to a maximum of 5%.

WARRANTY CLAUSE:

The supplied material should be guaranteed for period of 18 months after delivery or 12 months after commissioning whichever is earlier against faulty design/poor workmanship/manufacturing defect/deformation in requisite quality.

FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:

If the performance in whole or in part or any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by any reason of FM for a period exceeding 90 days, either party may at its option terminate the contract without any financial repercussion on either side.
